Good Morning, welcome to the worship services of the Leoma church of Christ! It is a wonderful blessing to be gathered today as a church family. If you are visiting with us, thank you so much for coming today! I am thankful to be back after a successful L2L weekend. I want to personally thank each one who helped in this process for 2018. Many prayed, many donated, many coordinated, many encouraged, many supported, and many showed up to help motivate. Without all these things L2L would not be nearly as successful.

I believe we are really blessed with many opportunities in our world today to spread the good news of Jesus Christ. I am confident we are taking advantage of many of them here at Leoma and I know there are others that hopefully in the future we can utilize. I just want to take this opportunity to remind you of the technological resources that we have at our finger tips. If you have a need perhaps you could access some of this material. First, you have our "What Really Matters for Today" spots on all Radio7Media networks. That includes WLX, the X, and WDXE on the radio. Basically 17 different frequencies on your radio including both FM and AM stations. These air 3 times each weekday randomly, with each having one set lunch spot just after the news. Second, on WDXE 105.3FM, we have a 15 spot in rotation with other congregations in Lawrence county called "Searching the Scriptures" that airs every weekday at 12:45pm. Third, we have a weekly program at 10:00am on Sunday mornings on WDXE 105.3FM that airs last week's sermon. Then, you have our Facebook page that posts a video of the one minute "What Really Matters for Today" spots each weeknight. We also have a YouTube channel where you can go online and watch recorded lessons. Just this year, we added our video spots to "TV NOW" on Lawrenceburg Now's website. The Lord has blessed us with so many great tools and I am thankful we are using so many of them to get the message of the truth to the world. Please pray about these works and use them as an opportunity to get your family and friends "tuned in" to the truth of God's word coming from the Leoma church of Christ.
