# Roamin' with Rodney...

Good Morning! It is a blessing to be together this morning for worship. If you are visiting, thank you for coming our way and please do it again soon! I hope you are not feeling the effects of the hour of sleep you lost last night. If so plan you a long nap this afternoon, not during worship! I know it does affect all of us, but I would think for the most part it is a blessing. From longer afternoons of daylight, to warmer days in general, longer days of sunshine, and the blooming and greening of all the creation. I just feel like those things help most people, I know they are helpful for me. I enjoy most of all I love the reminder that God is still in control and the world around us is alive!

This morning's lesson involves a passage from Acts 6 that is most often used to talk about deacons. As we have before, we will continue today to look at the book of Acts in a fresh and sometimes different way than what is typically the focus. I realize in our lesson text that men were appointed to carry out a work in the church that was not being addressed. There were specific men that were selected from among the congregation of people. The apostles made a special appointing process for them and then left them to the work. The church was pleased with the outcome, people were being taught continually, and the Lord was adding to the number daily. Looking at the text, consider why the problem occurred? What was the reaction time? How did those who reacted do so? Who were the ones to react? Who was then involved in the process? How does all this work together? What can a church today learn from it?

Tonight, we will start an overview of the book of Luke from our devotional books. Last week you read from the first chapter of the book, but I wanted to wait and give more attention to introductory details tonight. We know the author as the physician (Colossians 4:14), Luke, who was a Greek more than likely writing to a Greek audience. There seems to be a real focus on prayer and the Holy Spirit in Luke's perspective of the life of Christ. There are seven prayers found in the book of Luke and the Holy Spirit is referenced as filling those in the book who play a dominant role in the life of Jesus, even Jesus himself! I hope you will be here tonight to study with me from Luke 1-6.
