Roamin’ with Rodney...

Good Morning and Welcome! It is great to be together and see you here with us this morning. If you are a visitor this morning, thank you so much for choosing to come to Leoma. I pray that you will have opportunity to meet several people and will want to come back and worship with us again soon. As a member here, I plead with everyone else to keep your eyes up and your hearts opened to welcoming and visiting with those who are visitors. I hope that our warm Leoma welcome is extended your way and you feel valued today. I know God values you, you mean so much to Him, and to recognize that you are here to worship God is such a wonderful blessing.

This morning’s lesson is on the “wayside” soil. There were some seeds that fell to the path, or just outside the edge of the field. While there was nothing wrong with the sower or the seed, we are taught from the very beginning of this explanation that only 25% of the seed falls on good and honest soil and is able to bring fruit to maturity. The wayside heart is not prepared at all to receive the seed. They are called the “unresponsive hearts.” They hear the word just like the rest of the soils, but they refuse to allow the word to get any deeper than the ear canal. They plan to continue in whatever life practices they have, whether they be sinful or not. Sadly enough, when the heart has been hardened, Satan is immediate in snatching away the seed. Even though the heart is hard, the evil one is not willing to sit idle and allow the chance for the seed to have the opportunity to penetrate at all. These hearts are unbelievers and will be lost in the final judgement. Who is it that has a “wayside” heart? How do we keep our hearts from becoming hardened to the point of not allowing the seed to sink in?

This evening, I am looking forward to seeing and hearing about Jesse’s recent trip to our mission point in India. I know that many things on this trip were difficult because many hard decisions had to be made. However, I am confident the time visiting with Titus, Chandrapaul, and the family was very encouraging for them. I hope you will be here this evening to get a report on the Lord’s work that is going on in India, where God is using us and many others to help support and carry on the training of preachers and the spread of the gospel.
