Roamin’ with Rodney...

Good Morning and Welcome! I am so thankful you are here. Your presence is a great encouragement to me. If you are visiting, thank you for choosing Leoma as your place of worship today. I pray that your spiritual life will be blessed by this decision. If you are a member here, I am thankful you made worship a priority and were healthy enough to be here today. Everyone matters in the kingdom. Everyone is important to God. When you miss, God feels it and I pray that we all feel the absence of your presence because we are family!

Today’s parable might be one of the most familiar in all the scripture, The Samaritan Man. I always hesitate to call him the “good Samaritan” because Jesus never did that. However, I also admit that few people know the story of the Samaritan man, but most all know the story of the good Samaritan. Really what we will see is that he was neighborly. Jesus was not trying to illustrate good, He was trying to illustrate how to be neighborly. I understand the desire for eternal life and to be pleasing to God. I know that doing what God requires of us is very important. However, I am afraid that sometimes we can get caught up on “checking the list” for Christianity and miss what it means to be a “good” person who loves the Lord and his neighbor.

So, what does it mean to be a neighbor in our world today? Who is your neighbor? How does your treatment of others affect your ability to be a good influence for the Lord? What attitudes are you displaying to others? Those are just some of the questions we need to address this evening as we dig deeper into the conversation between Jesus and this lawyer! What we say matters, only when what we do matches! Who we are will be much more powerful in influence than who we claim to be. And you know as well as I do that people know who you are, not what you claim to be in life!

So how can I have a better attitude and focus in life? We see from the parable in Luke 10 a wide variety of attitudes. We are all capable of being the robbers, the priest, the Levite, the Samaritan, or even the man left for dead. Does what you have experienced in life affect how you view others in that situation in life? Did being a Samaritan actually give the man an advantage to know how to live true Christianity? I thought the Jews would have had the advantage?

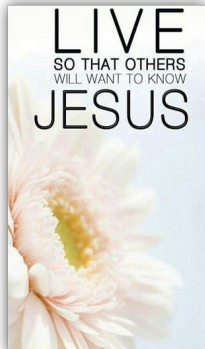
